

Q: When does enrolment begin?

A: Enrolment takes place from **Tuesday 26th August** through to **Tuesday 2nd September** following completion of your online enrolment portal steps

Q: Do I need to come in for enrolment?

A: Please **do not** come to the campus, enrolment is done virtually. You will not need to come to college until term begins which is from **Wednesday 3rd September** (subject to your timetable).

Q: How is enrolment prioritised?

A: Enrolment is prioritised on application date order starting with those who applied from **October 2024** through to **September 2025** and completion of the enrolment steps.

Q: I haven't achieved the entry requirements for my course, what should I do?

A: **We strongly recommend you do not re-apply for courses**. Our academic teams will review your grades and contact you to discuss alternative courses/levels through the enrolment week (**Tuesday 26th August** through to **Tuesday 2nd September**).

Q: When does term begin?

A: Term begins from **Wednesday 3rd September** (this will also be subject to your timetable).

Q: What happens if my course is full?

A: Every course has a capacity we must adhere to. Enrolment is prioritised on application date order starting with those who applied from **October 2024** through to **September 2025**. If by the time our academic team reach your application the course is full, they will contact you to discuss alternatives. **We strongly recommend you do not re-apply for courses**.

Q: Do I need to apply for Maths and English if I haven't achieved a Grade 4?

A: If you are under 19 and have not achieved a Grade 4 in Maths and English you **do not** need to apply for this, we will add this to your timetable when you are enrolled.
